



Customer Drawing Specifications for the City of Georgetown

All drawings submitting by the Customer to the City of Georgetown must be according to the following specifications:

A utility design CAD file must be submitted to the City of Georgetown on all projects. The DWG exported as a Shapefile is preferred. A CAD file is an AutoCAD-compatible (DXF or DWG file format) digital, while the Shapefiles should be ESRI compatible. The submitted files must contain specific point, line and text objects related to the design and analysis of existing and proposed utility lines in the proposed land development. All files should be drawn to scale.

CAD and Shapefiles Requirements:

- Coordinate System: NAD 83 Texas Central Zone 4203, Zone TX C
 - Units: Survey Feet
 - UTM Zone: 13 (UTM North)
- Objects and Data Requirements:
 - Requested Point of Service
 - Property Lines
 - Lot Lines
 - Curb Lines
 - All Easements
 - Water Lines
 - Gas Lines
 - Other Utilities
 - Flood control and retention ponds
 - Buildings, existing and proposed
 - Lot numbers
 - Heritage Trees

As part of the parcel data, please only include objects associated with this parcel. Customer is responsible for assuring that the data supplied to the City of Georgetown is current throughout all the project design phases. If there are any changes to the parcel data or the building footprint, the City of Georgetown will require an updated CAD or Shapefile.
